On the IDPs of Al Waer Neighborhood

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Introduction

The neighborhood of Al Waer is located in the western side of Homs city. It is considered the last stronghold of the rebels in the city as regime controlled all neighborhoods aftermath the annihilation campaign in an attempt for suppressing the revolution in the city. The geographical location of Al Waer neighborhood was a merit for regime forces for laying siege on the neighborhood from all sides.

The neighborhood was a home for about 50k people. However, a huge number of people fled towards Al Waer as 300k people resided it. Starvation and siege were the weapons of Assad regime for displacing the people and achieving the demographic change. About 200k people fled the neighborhood towards the camps in northern Syria. On February 2017, the regime forces launched a vicious military campaign on this neighborhood, which lasted for one bloody month. An agreement was made for displacing the populations to three destinations; Idlib, Jarabulus, and northern countryside of Homs.
