FINAL RECORD OF DECISIONS

I. CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

A. Prolongation of measures in relation with COVID-19

The Chair informed the Coordinators about the extension of the current restrictions related to COVID-19 until 28 August 2020 (President's decision of 24 June and 28 May 2020). In line with these decisions, committee delegations, hearings, participation in Parliamentary Assemblies and bodies thereof, election observation delegations and events organised by committees, among others, remain cancelled.

The Chair explained that the current technical and logistical limitations for committee meetings will most likely continue and pledged to focus on core business. The Secretariat is trying to book the following dates for AFET meetings after summer: 1, 10, 21 and 28 September.

While respecting the preventive and health-security measures, the Chair announced that for exchanges of views in AFET, he strongly recommends the institutional speakers (from EEAS and the Commission) to be present in the meeting room in order to facilitate the debate.

B. AFET requests to the Conference of Committee Chairs / Conference of Presidents - state of play of authorisations

The Chair informed the Coordinators that following AFETs' request for own-initiative reports are still pending authorisation:

1. The EU and the defence of multilateralism (INTA to be associated under Rule 57)
2. Connectivity and EU-Asia relations
3. the Arctic: opportunities, concerns and security challenges
4. Promoting regional stability and security in the broader Middle East region
5. Foreign policy consequences of the COVID-19 outbreak
6. Annual Recommendation on EU priorities for the UN General Assembly.

On 22 June EPP group withdrew its proposal for an INI: Migration and security issue in a fragile state bordering with EU: Bosnia and Herzegovina

The Coordinators raised the issue that own-initiative reports are core business for AFET and therefore the importance of their authorisation will be raised in CCC and among political groups.

C. Pre-FAC briefings by the High Representative

The Chair informed the Coordinators that he would like to resume the regular briefings before Foreign Affairs Council (FAC) meetings after the summer recess if conditions allow.
