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The Working Program for the Political Committee for Syrian Detainees (PCSD) and Association for The Defence of the Detainees in Syria (ADDS)

Concepts, objectives and mechanism of work :

Since the exponential increase in the war crimes against humanity committed by Assad regime and his allies in Syria, we at the PCSD believe that the only way to implement peace and justice in Syria is by holding perpetrators to accountability and submitting them to fair trials.

Concepts,

1. detainees must get released unconditionally and outside any political negotiations, they must not be used as a pressure or bargain tool.
2. detainees file should be solved as one file and must not be fragmented into subtitles, postponed or deleted.
3. detainees file cannot be disregarded with time.
4. detainees have been tortured and died constantly in notorious Assad prisons for the last eight years, forcibly disappeared, mostly with unknown fate, the Assad regime must expose number, identity, circumstances of death, death certificate, and health condition for the survivors
5. any military success in submitting ordinary Syrian to Assad regime by targeting civilians areas with excessive force using internationally prohibited weapons and all kind of barbaric bombardment will not be considered as a victory, in fact it will considered as a crime against humanity
6. Assad military victory as described by his supporters will not give him any legitimacy or rehabilitation as a president of Syria, he will continue to be hold accountable for war crimes committed in Syria, he must get prosecuted.

Objectives

1. To hold all perpetrators in Syria including ISIS and Assad regime accountable for the committed war crimes against humanity and bring them to fair trial locally or internationally.
2. cooperate and collaborate with United Nation and the sympathised international communities to

achieve justice in Syria.

3. expose and deter Assad allies like Russia, and Iran from supporting and helping war criminals in Syria, and hold them accountable for sharing war crime against humanity against innocent Syrian people.

Mechanism of work :

1. collecting, preserving, consolidating, analysing and sharing evidence with international bodies concerned about detainees in Syria.
2. exclusive cooperation and collaboration with United Nation through the memorandum of understanding with the Impartial and Independent Mechanism to Assist in the Investigation and Prosecution of Persons Responsible for the Most Serious Crimes under International Law committed in the Syrian Arab Republic since March 2001
3. participate in all activities, meetings and conferences dealing with the accountability for war crimes committed in Syria and to push this file to a high level of urgency and implementation
4. publishing articles and alerts on up to date information regarding detainees in Syria
5. communicating and corresponding with all international governments and bodies interested in justice for detainees file
6. run frequent visits to UN and western governments interested in achieving justice in Syria and holding perpetrators accountable by implementing security council resolutions specially resolution 2254 and 2118
7. each member of PCSD in his own country is our local representative to his own government and he can deliver our statement regularly
8. collaborating with media cover at all levels to pass our voices and statements to the public and raise awareness about our activities
9. building up confidential and strong relationship with influential politicians, governments, human right activists, journalists and united nation representatives
10. keep developing and promoting our data base of information regarding detainees in Syria, monitoring, analysing and verifying our data, and get it ready to implement evidences at the international criminal courts
