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The number of internally displaced people in Syria exceeds 7 million. The United Nations expects the number of Syrian refugees in neighboring counties to reach up to 4.1 million at the end of 2014. Such figures highlight the scale of the suffering of the Syrian people, and they surely mean one thing; there is no more a safe place in Syria.

Backed by its regional and international allies, the Assad regime sought to change the nature of the conflict in Syria by adopting a state policy of displacing people.

After more than 1000 days since the start of the Syrian Revolution, the Assad regime managed to succeed in creating the worst humanitarian crisis in a century.
