

The OIC Condemns the Terrorist Attack against Jordanian Border Guards in Rukban Area on the Border with Syria

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The General Secretariat of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) denounced the terrorist attack on Jordanian border guards in Rukban area on the border with Syria, which claimed the lives of many Jordanian soldiers and injured others.

The OIC Secretary General expressed sincere condolences to the families of the victims and to the king, government and people of Jordan, reiterating the OIC's solidarity with the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan in its war against terrorism, which targets the security and stability of the entire region and consequently exacerbates the humanitarian situation there.
