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The Secretary General of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC), Professor Ekmeleddin Ihsanoglu, condemned strongly the dreadful massacre perpetrated in Tremseh village in Hama, Syria, on 12 July 2012, which caused the death and injury of hundreds of unarmed civilians. The OIC Secretary General denounced the continuation of the killing and bloodsheds targeting the Syrian people, particularly as the holy month of Ramadan is approaching. The Secretary General called on the UN Security Council again to take all measures made possible under the UN Charter with a view to putting an end to the bloodshed in Syria and protect the Syrian people.
