Mr. ROSS (for himself, Mr. POSEY, Mr. TIPTON, and Mr. COLLINS of New York) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit obligation of Federal funds for admission of
refugees from Syria, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on the date of the en-
5 actment of this Act, no Federal funds may be obligated
6 for the admission into the United States under section 207
7 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1157)
8 as a refugee (as defined in section 101(a)(42) of such Act
9 (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(42))) of any alien described in sub-
10 section (b).

1 (b) ALIENS DESCRIBED.—An alien is described in
2 this subsection if—

3 (1) the country of the alien's nationality is
4 Syria; or

5 (2) in the case of an alien having no nation-
6 ality, the country in which the alien last habitually
7 resided was Syria.

8 (c) TERMINATION.—The prohibition in subsection (a)
9 shall terminate only upon the approval in the House of
10 Representatives and in the Senate of a resolution termi-
11 nating such prohibition.

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
