

OIC GENERAL SECRETARIAT STRESSES NEED FOR LEBANESE PARTIES TO RESPECT LEBANON'S NON-INTERFERENCE DECISION IN SYRIA'S CRISIS

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The General Secretariat of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) has underscored the need for all Lebanese parties to respect Lebanon's decision to stay away and not interfere in any way in the Syrian crisis. The General Secretariat appealed to all Lebanese to work together to preserve security, peace and stability and to place Lebanon's higher interests above all considerations. It also called for immediate cessation of armed clashes in north Lebanon, and emphasized the need for peaceful coexistence among all sections of the Lebanese people. It also urged them to eschew everything that could stoke sectarian strife in the country and the region.
