FINAL RECORD OF DECISIONS

I. CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

A. Impact of COVID-19 outbreak on AFET activities

The Chair informed the Coordinators about the recent decisions of President Sassoli and the Conference of Presidents and recalled that Parliament is working in business continuity mode.

In the light of these decisions and guidelines, Coordinators have agreed via written procedure on 27 March 2020 on AFET priority files. The Coordinators have also requested an exchange of views with Vice-President of the European Commission/ High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy Josep Borrell on the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on foreign affairs (in association with DROI and SEDE subcommittees).

B. Committee input to Conference of Committee Chairs

The Chair informed the Coordinators about the postponement of the current deadlines for committee input to CCC procedures. New dates will be communicated as soon as possible.

C. Election of the Bureau of AFET Committee

The Chair informed the Coordinators that the votes on the election of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Vice-Chairs of AFET Committee are scheduled to take place at the next physical AFET meeting.

D. Reporting from UK Coordination Group

The Chair informed the Coordinators about the state of play of discussions and about a possible timeline of the joint AFET/INTA report (under rules 114 and 58 of the Rules of Procedures).

E. DEVE non-legislative own-initiative report “A new EU-Africa Strategy - a partnership for sustainable and inclusive development”

The Chair informed the Coordinators that the agreement on competences between DEVE, AFET and INTA was endorsed by the CoP of 5 March 2020. AFET and INTA would be associated under Rule 57.

AFET Committee will focus on the following issues within its exclusive competences:

- the common foreign and security policy (CFSP)
- the common security and defence policy (CSDP)
- the oversight of the European External Action Service

The strengthening of political relations with developing countries in Africa and relations with international African organisations will fall under the shared competences of AFET and DEVE applying Rule 57 of the Rules of Procedure.

F. Activities with National Parliaments - 2nd semester 2020

The Chair informed the Coordinators about a proposal to hold an inter-parliamentary committee meeting (ICM) in Brussels on 2 December.
