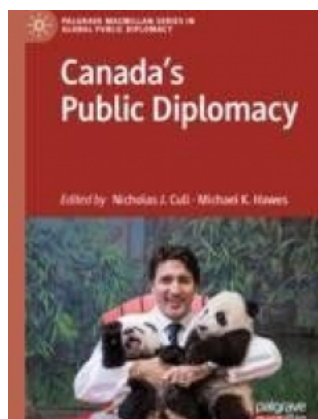

He contributes to the defence and promotion of human rights since 1996. He has worked or collaborated with several international and national human rights agencies, having taken part in multiple observation and training missions, and having produced several institutional reports. He advises or has advised many human rights and indigenous peoples' organizations, human rights defenders and attorneys, as well as international organizations and states. He regularly represents or assists victims and human rights defenders in several contentious cases before the Inter-American Human rights System, UN specialized agencies and mechanisms, the European Court of Human Rights, etc. Previously, Bernard Duhaime was an attorney at the Inter-American Commission on Human Rights of the Organization of American States and was also a Member of the UN Working Group on Enforced or Involuntary Disappearances.

Bernard Duhaime holds a BCL with distinction and an LLB with distinction from McGill University, and an LLM. summa cum Laude from the University of Notre Dame.

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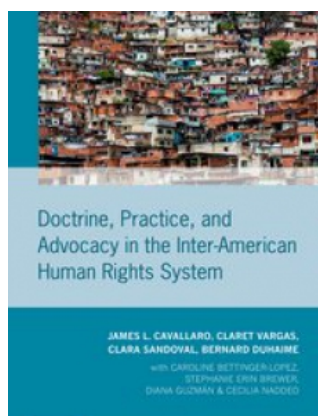
